

**EU Regulation on the prevention of deforestation (EUDR)
CH Timber Trade Ordinance (HHV)**

Dear Sir or Madam,

We hereby inform you about the status of implementation of the requirements of the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR).

In the trilogue procedure, the EU Parliament, Council, and Commission agreed on necessary amendments to the EU Regulation on deforestation-free products (EUDR).

Large companies are now required to implement the changes from December 30, 2026, while small companies will be granted a deferral until June 30, 2027.

But first, it is up to the EU to make the bureaucratic burden, which has recently been almost impossible to meet, practicable. Ultimately, the goal of avoiding deforestation should remain, but the requirements must also be feasible to implement across the entire value chain.

Through our FSC certification (FSC license code FSC® C131519), we guarantee comprehensive external verification of the above-mentioned issues and are also in regular contact with our suppliers to ensure that their products comply with legal requirements and, therefore, our products as well.

We would also like to point out that we attach great importance to the sustainability of the raw materials we use for our products.

We would also like to draw particular attention to point 7(a) of Annex 1. It is clarified that under HS code 4415 and HS code 4819, packaging material used for its intended purpose as packaging is not relevant to the EUDR.
